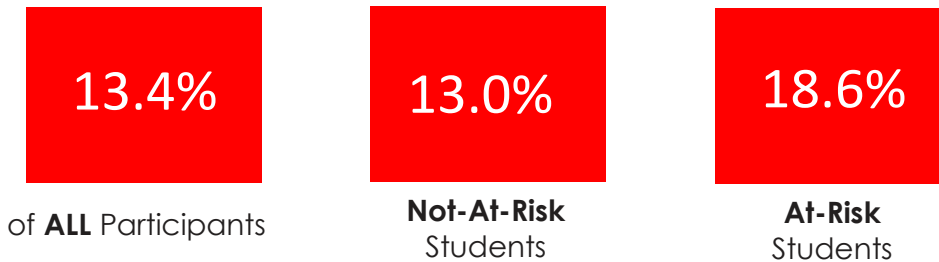
Student Performance Outcomes

Performance Outcomes

- 29.0% of all participants experienced an increase in GPA.
- "At-Risk" students experienced an 8.0% increase in GPA.
- 0.28% average percent increase in GPA among "At-Risk" students.

Sustained Improvement, Two-Year Change

- Average 0.41 GPA change for "At-Risk" Students, compared to 0.44 for "Not-At-Risk".
- Average 29.0% change in GPA percent for "At-Risk" students, compared to 12.0% for "Not-At-Risk".

The Wayne County Community Learning Center (WCCLC) program is an educational collaborative of community and business partners, including the Wayne County Board of Education and Playmates Preschools & Child development Centers. The Program provides after-school and summer assistance to Wayne County students. WCCLC offers 29 programs in Wayne County schools and Playmates locations and annually serves more than 2,540 students on average.
